**PROCEEDINGS: Pretrial Conference**

This matter was called for a Pretrial Conference, with parties and counsel present as noted. The Court having heard counsel and having been sufficiently advised, it is hereby

**ORDERED** as follows:

1. The trial remains set for June 4, 2012 beginning at 9:30am. Counsel shall be present at 9:00 a.m. the Court has set aside 10 days for trial.
2. The Clerk shall summon 50 jurors to be present for jury selection. After strikes for cause, the Clerk will select 32 jurors, the first 28 shall be regular jurors and the last 4 will be designated as potential alternates. The Defendant shall receive 10 peremptory challenges and the United States shall receive 6 peremptory challenges. Each party shall receive 1 peremptory strike for the panel of alternates. The first 12 jurors called but not stricken from the regular pool will comprise the jury and the first 2 alternates not stricken will be the alternate jurors.
3. The Court shall conduct the initial voir dire, with each side receiving 15 minutes to conduct any additional voir dire.
4. The parties' joint stipulations shall be due by May 25, 2012.
5. United States to file any responses to the Defendant's motions in limine and the Defendant shall file responses to any of the government's motions in limine on later than Friday, May 25, 2012. If the Court determines that a hearing is needed to resolve any issues raised by the parties' unresolved motion, such hearing will be scheduled beginning on Wednesday, May 30, 2012, beginning at the hour of 9:00 a.m.
6. The defendant is to remain on bond and on previously imposed conditions of release.
